


Leaving Certificate Applied (LCA)



What is LCA?

- It is a distinct, self-contained, two year Leaving Certificate Programme.
- One of its primary aims is to prepare students for adulthood and the world of work.
- It offers <u>alternative</u> methods of learning and assessment for your son or daughter.






What can it do for me?

Structure of LCA

You accumulate 200 Credits in 4 Sessions over the 2 years in 3 ways:

- The completion of each of 44 Modules. (62 Credits)
- 90% Attendance & Key Assignments.
- By completing 7 Tasks. (70 Credits)
- Completing 7 written exams over June of Year 1 and
 2. (68 Credits)

These results are combined to give your a Leaving Certificate Result.




As part of a group, I designed, carried out and reported on a survey on some aspects of working life.
