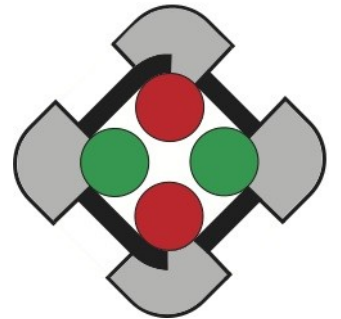

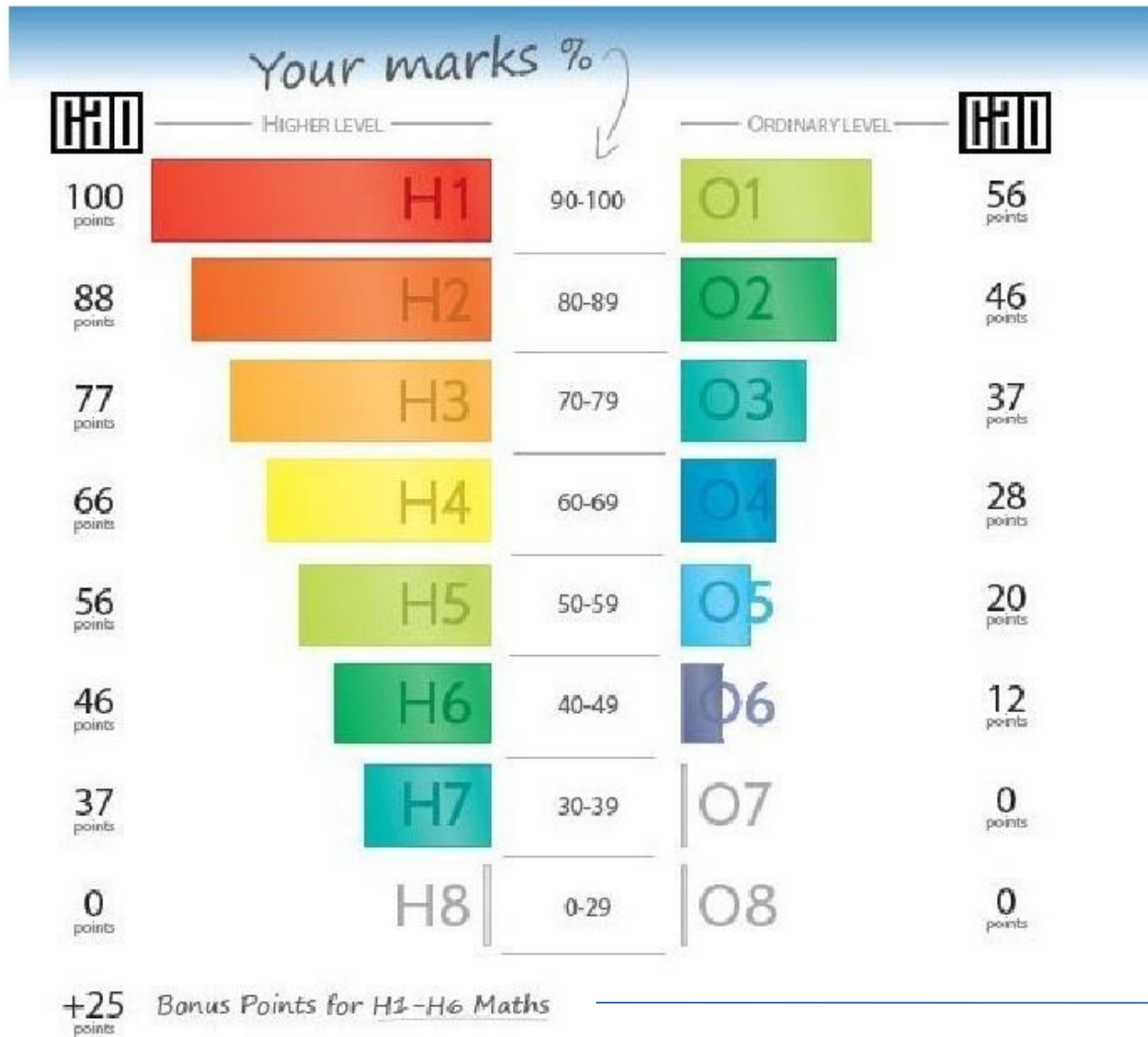

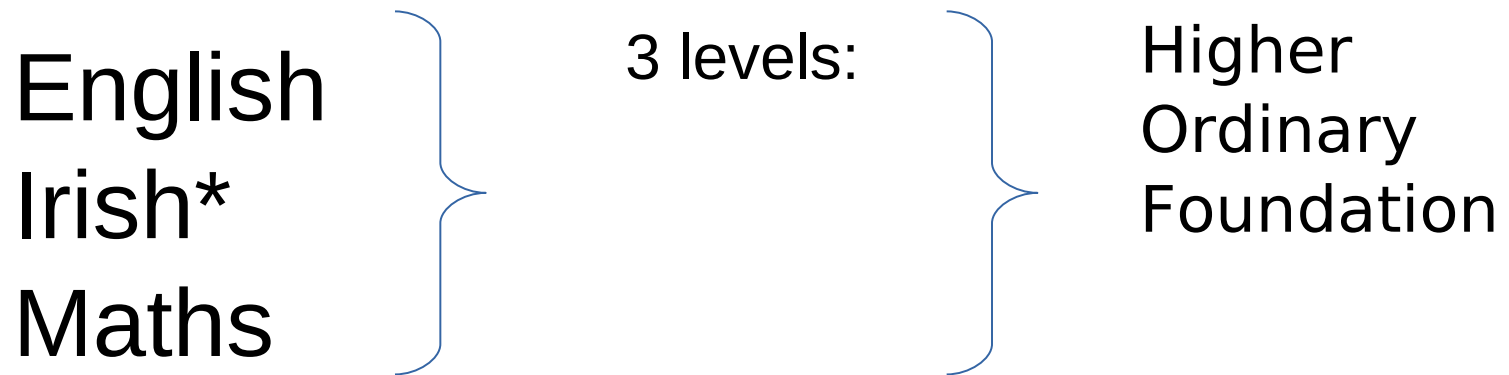

- Where possible stick with Honours Level
- Your choices should not totally depend on which teacher is teaching a certain subject
- The Junior Certificate is a full-time three year course
- Where a mistake is made rectify it as soon as possible
